1905 Minnesota State Census of Equality Township of Red Lake County, Minnesota, taken 03 Jun 1905 shows her (and Kinn family) living next door to Uncle Halvor Reindal.

The 1920 Federal Census lists Gordon Orlando CRITTENDEN as a "Hired Man" in the Kinn household. Gordon is a younger brother to Ethel CRITTENDEN (Ryan), mother of Hazel RYAN (Rendahl).

Per phone conversation with Blanche Rendahl on 20 June, 2003, "Gertrude" is buried in Concordia Lutheran Church's cemetery. I did not get a picture of her gravestone when visiting the Norwegian cemetery (also a Swedish cemetery affiliated with Concordia), as I did not know at that time (7/2/1999) who she was in relation to me.

The following was written by Ardis Hoffer (Ted's daughter) in a personal email dated Tue, 23 Dec 2003 21:30:39 EST re: Gro Rendahl-Kinn and offspring (repeated in its entirety here):

I called Audrey last night and she wasn't a bit of help, but this is what I have come up with. Chris Kinn was married to Grandpa Tom's sister but I can never remember the name Julia mentioned. She was always referred to as "GRO" in my memory, but Audrey says that means "old woman" in Norwegian so maybe her name was Julia.

Ha

Anyway, Chris Kinn had 3 boys and 1 girl that I can remember. Otto Kinn had 3 boys - Charles, Orlean, and Alvin. Ole Kinn had at least 6 kids, including Lucille, Wendall & Marvin. (can't remember the rest) There was also John Kinn but I know nothing about his family, and the girl was named Dena which is where the Kittleson clan comes in.

Dena Kinn married Henry Kittleson and they had 8 kids. I found out the number in an old Benedict history book. I can only come up with 7 kids but the book said 8 so I am missing one. They are Gladys Krebsbach (spelling is wrong) Tilda Peterson, Evelyn Erickson, Anna Olson, Elmo Kittleson, Art Kittleson, & Helen Bodecker (not sure of that spelling either) That would make Dena and my dad and your grandpa first cousins - right?

It has been so many years since I lived in that area that I just can't remember them. Charles Kinn and his wife were at my Dad's funeral last month. I didn't recognize him at first and we went to school together in the first through fifth grade. The Otto Kinn family was one of our closest neighbors on the farm.
