1880 Federal Census shows her living with hubby "Bennett T. Randall" in their son B.B. Reindal's home. Age was listed as 60yrs.

Register of Deaths, Twp of Pickerel Lake, County of Freeborn, State of Minnesota shows her name as "Grace Reindall". Her death occurred 04 Sept, 1886, and was recorded 16 Dec, 1886. Age listed as 67yrs. Place of birth was Norway. Cause of death was "consumption". Date of arrival in Minnesota shown as 1875 which is corroborated with other info. Parents were Halvor & Grace Fellon of Norway. Given the detail of this death recording, the birth year of 1817 comes into question, as it would appear that 1819 would be more accurate,

coroborated with the 1880 census age of 60yrs.

Mathilda showed up on the 1880 census as B.B.'s wife.

The date of the Baptism was 19 Aug 1883. Rev. Lundebj was pastor at Sheyenne Lutheran, and the Red Willow Lake congregation, amongst other churches he started.

The kids living in the household with them are: "Ben", born Apr 1879 in Minnesota, 21 years old; "Mikel", born May 1880 in Minnesota, 19 years old; "Edwin", born Apr 1884 in Minnesota, 16 years old; "Ole", born Mar 1886 in Minnesota, 14 years old; "Gerty", born Jun 1876 in Norway, 23 or 24 years old (last digit scratched out and written over); "Dina", listed as Granddaughter, born Feb 1896 in Minnesota, 4 years old.

1920 Federal Census of Township 149, Range 82, of McLean County, North Dakota, done in January-February of that year, lists Ole Rendahl, father, age 72, born in Norway, immigrated 1878, naturalized 1916. Wife, Tillie, mother, age 78, born in Norway, immigrated 1878, naturalized 1916. Living with son, Ole. (Volume 14, E.D. 115, Sheet 9, Line 41) (Record Group 29, Publication T625, Roll No. 1336)

Grave marker in Concordia Lutheran Church Cemetery has dates of 1852-1922.

Blanche Rendahl (Alfred's wife) sent a scanned image of a picture she has of the family when the "kids" were still in the household, estimating that the eldest, Gertrude (Gro), was in her middle to late teens. There was no Theodore captioned in the picture. For this reason, and for the reason that there is a Theodore in Halvor Reindal's line, I have deleted Theodore from Ole Bendik Rendahl's progeny. The picture appears to have been taken in a photo studio by a professional photographer.

Norway. The ship was the *Angelo*, and once they arrived, they made their way to Albert Lea, MN, Freeborn County." After further independent review, the *Angelo* was a ship that took them from Oslo to England, where they then caught another ship (name unknown as of 20 June, 2003) to America.

BLM Records for surnames "O-R" inclusive for Nelson County, North Dakota shows three listings for "Torger B. Reindal" all dated 11/02/1889 for Meridian 5, Twp 149N, Range 60W, Section 31. Each plot was 80, 37.49, and 37.7 acres, and all were acquired by cash purchase.

Burial information on Tarjei came from the first letter of Allen Osmundson of Binford, North Dakota. To quote: "On Thanksgiving Day, 29 Nov. 1888, occurred the committal service for Tarjei (or Torger, in English) Reindal at the Sheyenne Lutheran cemetery along the Sheyenne River, about 3 miles south of the present day Pekin, ND. Tarjei, age 26, had been born in Telemark, Norway, Rev Lundeby noted in his journal." The problem with this is that later on in the same letter package from Allen, there is a news item in the Jan 6, 1888 Griggs County Courier that stated :Thomas Reindahl died at his farm in the northwest part of the county (Griggs) of typhoid pneumonia, aged 27 years. He died on Friday, Dec 31, 1887.

Tarjei apparently didn't have a gravestone, per visit to the Sheyenne Lutheran Church cemetery on Sun, 19 Oct, 2008. No gravestone was found.
